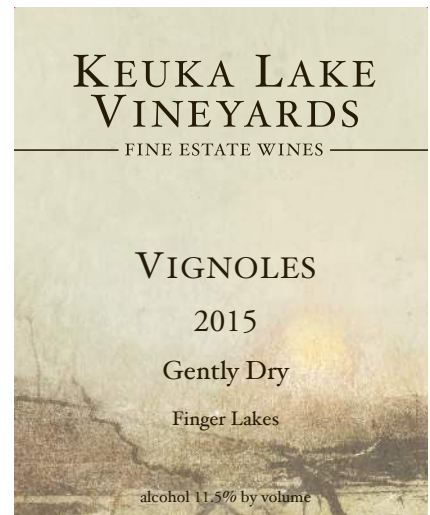

Machine harvested
Settled in tank for 24 hours
Racked, inoculated with
Alchemy 1
10-day fermentation at 56°F
Racked from gross lees

Turkey Run

Hand harvested
Settled in tank for 24 hours
Racked, inoculated with X5
16-day fermentation at 58°F
Sur lees ageing with stirring

Silvernail

Hand harvested
Settled in tank for 24 hours
Racked, inoculated with X5
18-day fermentation at 60°F
Racked from gross lees

Blended all lots after 9 months of ageing
Vegan friendly
Sterile filtered at bottling

Vineyards

Bedient Vineyards is located on the northwest side of Keuka Lake and is run by Jim Bedient, a second-generation grape grower. The site sits on sandy soils that produce highly vigorous vines and work very well with hybrid grape varieties. Turkey Run Vineyard is just over 1 ½ acres planted on thin intermittent layers of clay mixed with dense glacial till. The vineyard is sloped to 15%, where erosion has allowed the dense stone to remain at the soil surface. The Silvernail Vineyard is 3 ½ acres of Vignoles planted down the hill from Turkey Run. They share similar soil profiles but the Silvernail site is far less steep.
